

SCHEDULE 1

Conditions of Accreditation

1. The accredited meat producer must comply with the Meat and Poultry Food Safety Scheme in all respects.
2. All primary production activities authorised by this accreditation must be undertaken in accordance with an approved food safety program.
3. Subject to conditions 1 and 2, the primary production activities authorised by this accreditation are to be undertaken at the following premises or place –
 - (a) the business address; and
 - (b) in respect to the transport of meat or meat products, anywhere within Australia
4. The accredited meat producer must allow a relevant food safety auditor to enter any premises or place referred to in condition 3, or in any vehicle being used for the transport of meat or meat products by the accredited producer, to conduct audits required under the Act.
5. The accredited meat producer must pay, in accordance with the requirements of the Chief Inspector, the reasonable costs and expenses associated with audits conducted under the Act.
